001. NAME AND CLASSIFICATION	
<p>SC 1807, 1840.1, 1850.1, 1850.3</p>	<p>Section 1. <u>Name</u></p> <p>The Board of School Directors shall be known officially as the Joint Board of Venango Technology Center, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Joint Board.</p> <p>The Joint Committee of Venango Technology Center shall consist of those members chosen by the Joint Board.</p>
<p>Articles of Agreement SC 1807 Title 22 Sec. 4.35</p>	<p>Section 2. <u>Composition</u></p> <p>Venango Technology Center is comprised of the following participating school districts: Cranberry Area, Forest Area, Franklin Area, Oil City Area, Titusville Area, and Valley Grove.</p>
<p>SC 502, 1841 Title 22 Sec. 4.3</p>	<p>Section 3. <u>Purpose</u></p> <p>The Venango Technology Center is organized for the purpose of providing a program of vocational and technical training and education to students, out-of-school youth and adults residing within the participating school districts.</p>
<p>SC 951, 952</p>	<p>Section 4. <u>Intermediate Unit</u></p> <p>Venango Technology Center is assigned to Riverview Intermediate Unit No. 6.</p>
<p>SC 1850.1</p>	<p>Section 5. <u>Classification</u></p> <p>The Venango Technology Center cannot be classified as a school district. However, to the extent it is consistent with Article 18 of the Pennsylvania School Code, it shall follow the mandates set forth for a third class school district.</p>
