EXTRACURRICULAR PARTICIPATION BY CHARTER/CYBER CHARTER STUDENTS</p> <p>The Joint Committee shall approve participation in the center’s extracurricular activities by a student enrolled in a charter or cyber charter school if all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The student is a resident of a participating school district. 2. The charter or cyber charter school does not provide the same extracurricular activity. 3. The student fulfills all eligibility criteria required for participation in an activity by center students, in accordance with Joint Committee policy. <p>The Joint Committee shall not provide individual transportation for students enrolled in charter or cyber charter schools who participate in the center’s extracurricular activities. When the center provides transportation to and from an away competition, game, event or exhibition and requires center students to use provided transportation, charter/cyber charter students shall be required to use the transportation provided by the center.</p> <p>The Joint Committee may require the charter or cyber charter school to pay the cost of the expenses for its students’ participation in the center’s extracurricular activities.</p> <p>Charter and cyber charter school students shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions and participate in the center’s extracurricular activities.</p> <p>A charter or cyber charter school student may only participate in extracurricular activities at the school the student would be assigned to if s/he was enrolled in a participating school district.</p>

Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>If a class for credit held during the school day by the center is required for participation in activities that take place outside of the class, charter/cyber charter students shall not be eligible to participate in such activities.</p> <p>The following guidelines shall govern participation in the center’s extracurricular activities by eligible charter and cyber charter school students, who shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Meet the required eligibility criteria. 2. Maintain appropriate insurance coverage, consistent with the coverage requirements for students enrolled in the center. 3. Comply with Joint Committee policies and center rules and regulations regarding extracurricular activities and student discipline. 4. Comply with policies, rules and regulations of the activity’s governing organization. 5. Meet attendance and reporting requirements established for all participants of the activity. 6. Meet the requirements for physical examinations, physical fitness and any height and/or weight restrictions. 7. Comply with all requirements and directives of the staff, coaches and administrators involved with the extracurricular activity. <p>The Coordinator of Student Services or designee shall receive and review written verification from the charter or cyber charter school that a student has met and continues to meet the established eligibility criteria for an extracurricular activity.</p> <p>The center shall distribute information regarding eligibility criteria and student participation in extracurricular activities to all affected by them.</p> <p>The center shall ensure that charter and cyber charter students have access to information regarding the center’s extracurricular activities.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
