| 224. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY                   |  |
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| 1. Purpose                                     | The Joint Committee believes that the center should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.   |
| 2. Authority                                   | The Joint Committee charges each student in the center with responsibility for the proper care of the school property, school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.   |
| SC 777<br>Pol. 218, 233                        | It is the policy of the Joint Committee that students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents/Guardians shall be held accountable for the actions of the student.  |
| SC 1338  | The Joint Committee may report to appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property is serious or chronic in nature. In no case shall referral to juvenile authorities be made without prior notification to the student's parent/guardian.   |
| 3. Delegation of Responsibility<br>SC 109, 801 | The Director or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy which include rules for safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies and equipment and an established schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment.<br><br>The Director shall submit a report on incidences of vandalism to the Joint Committee on each occurrence.<br><br>Vandalism reports shall include the number and kind of incident, cost to the school, and related information the Director deems necessary. |
