	<p align="center">912. RELATIONS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS</p>
<p>1. Authority</p>	<p>The center in which students are in attendance has the responsibility and authority for them. In order for those students to receive maximum benefit from their program of studies, articulation between the technical school and the participating school districts is essential.</p> <p>It is the policy of the Joint Committee that incentive of communication be maintained with institutions that provide programs, training or services available to students and with participating districts whose resident students are enrolled in programs of the center.</p>
<p>2. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>Maintaining cordial and constructive relationships with other educational institutions shall be the responsibility of the Director or designee.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines</p>	<p><u>Post-High School Articulation Agreements</u></p> <p>The Venango Technology Center has articulation agreements with several higher education schools, colleges, and universities. Graduating seniors who are planning on furthering their education should check with the Student Services Office to see if the school they are planning to attend has an articulation agreement with the Venango Technology Center. Articulation agreements permit students to receive college credit for competencies they have obtained at the center.
